The University of North Texas Completes State-of-the-Art Video Conferencing Installation
Technology allows students and faculty to connect and share in new ways

HOUSTON, Texas – (March 30, 2010) – CCS Presentation Systems Texas, one of the largest audio and visual equipment integrators in the U.S., is proud to announce the completion of the new videoconferencing system at The University of North Texas (UNT) Center for Learning Enhancement, Assessment and Redesign. The state-of-the-art video conferencing system was completed January 14, 2010 for the room's first event - a video conferencing seminar with Gerda Weissmann Klein, a Holocaust survivor, who told her story of survival during World War II to a room full of 40 plus students in Denton from her home in Arizona.

The University of North Texas Videoconferencing Network (UNTVN) is a compressed video network connecting several videoconferencing classrooms in the Dallas/Fort Worth Metroplex. The new videoconference room at Chilton Hall showcases state-of-the-art technology including an 'invisible theater' speaker system that produces content audio directly behind and from the viewable image. With a diagonal of almost 16 feet, the painted screen draws attention and allows for greater detail in a multiple screen layout.

"It is an honor to contribute to the growth and integration of technology at UNT.
