Arizona Growth Helps Scottsdale-based A/V Integrator Reach \$145 Million in Sales**

SCOTTSDALE, Ariz. – (January 22, 2008) – CCS Presentation Systems, the largest integrator of audio and visual equipment in the Southwest, today announced that its 2007 U.S. sales reached \$145 million making the company the third largest A/V integrator in the U.S. by revenue and installations. CCS's sales were largely driven by the growth in the commercial and education sectors nationwide and the company's strong sales in Arizona.

Arizona sales were \$47 million, which reflected an increase of 22 percent over the previous year. The company's overall U.S. sales grew by nearly 10 percent and have done so each year since 1999.

"Audio and video technology may not be top of mind for most consumers, but in this digital age visual media has become pervasive in our culture and part of every building project from residential and commercial development to retail and educational spaces," said John Godbout, founder and chief operating officer of CCS Presentation Systems.

CCS offers multiple product lines to enhance presentation effectiveness and customer experiences including interactive SMART™ Boards, LCD & plasma displays, projectors and projection screens.
