**CCS PRESENTATION SYSTEMS POSTS RECORD REVENUE IN 2009
Scottsdale-based A/V Integrator Reaches \$162 Million Mark**

SCOTTSDALE, Ariz. – (January 28, 2010) – CCS Presentation Systems, the largest integrator of audio and visual equipment in the Southwest, today announced that its 2009 U.S. revenue reached \$162 million, making the company one of the largest a/v integrators in the country by revenue. Also contributing to the increased revenue, was the success of their online sales channel, Projector Superstore that was launched in 1996 and resulted in \$7.2 million in revenue last year.
